General Conditions

Entry Conditions

- All entries to be made via Horse Monkey only.
- No entry will be accepted without the appropriate fee and £4 per rider/handler for first aid cover.
- On booking confirmation via Horse Monkey you, and any other competitor or groom, agree to all general conditions stated.
- Mainland Entries please contact the office in advance for travel arrangements and/or stabling requirements and be prepared to book early on the ferries. Wightlink (0871 3761000) www.wightlink.co.uk or Red Funnel (0844 844 9988) www.redfunnel.co.uk. Lorries/trailers should be booked via freight services.
- There can be no substitutions and no return of fees after the closing date unless a vet's or doctor's certificate is produced.
- Closing date for all entries Saturday 4th July.
- Admission passes will be allocated as follows: 1 horse entered – 3 wristband passes, 2 horses entered – 4 wristband passes, 3 horses entered – 5 wristband passes. Fancy dress entry – 1 wristband only. Thereafter 1 wristband pass per horse up to a maximum of 6 wristband passes. This allocation is only intended to relate to those preparing, handling or riding animals. Admission tickets for additional guests may be purchased at the public entrance gate. Passes & numbers will be available to collect from The County Show Office between 6pm to 8pm Tuesday 7th July and Thursday 9th July only.
- No entry to showground will be permitted without a wristband. Wristbands will be checked on the gate.
- All equines entered must have a registered horse passport which must be available for inspection by Trading Standards and/or DEFRA at the show.
- All horses and ponies entered must have a current equine influenza vaccination course in accordance with the relevant vaccination rules, and proof of vaccination must be available on request.

Entry fees, prize money and trophies

- Entry fees for all classes: £18*. Inter Team Relay £25 per Team. (Members may claim a discount of £3 per entry on application to the Show Office with proof of entry & their Membership Number) *With the exception of Class 32, Fancy Dress – Entry Fee £5.
- Showing prize money 2026, each Class £20, £10 & £5, each Champion £20 & rosette, each Reserve Champion £10 & rosette, "Supreme of the Show" Champion £250, Reserve Champion £150, This Championship is kindly sponsored by *MR AGRI*
- Showjumping and Arena Eventing prize money 2026, each class £20, £10 & £5.
- Certain cups and trophies must remain with the society, therefore competitors who win a cup may be presented with a replacement trophy. Cup winners are responsible for insuring cups whilst in their possession and for returning them in the condition that they were awarded in.
- All cups must be returned to the County Show Office, Shide Meadows Centre, Shide Road, Newport, PO30 1HR (Entrance by National Tyre Centre) before Monday 15th June 2026.

Health and Safety

- First Aid cover will be available on the Showground. Vectis Equine Vets (01983 533799) will be on direct call.
- The Show Committee and the Landowners accept no liability for any occurrence on the Showground. Competitors and their supporters and friends are required to have regard for the Health and Safety of others. The onus is on every rider who suffers a fall or anybody who suffers an injury whilst on the Showground, to report the fall/injury to the Show Secretary.
- All competitors should have their own third-party liability insurance.
- Instructions from the Safety Officer and all stewards are to be followed at all times. Failure to do so will result in dismissal from the Showground. Any offensive language or behaviour will not be tolerated and will result in dismissal from the showground.

- Horses/ponies and riders must stay within designated areas. Horses/ponies are not permitted in public areas.
- Horses tied to boxes must not be left unattended.
- All rubbish must be removed and Horseboxes and Trailers must not be cleaned out on the Showground. Please clear hay debris, droppings, etc from around your box/trailer.
- Dogs are to be kept on leads at all times.
- Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats Nos. PAS015 2011, VG1, (BS) EN1384 2023, ASTM F1163 2015 and 2023, SNELL E2016 and E2021, AS/NZS 3838 2006, must be worn by riders at all times when mounted on the Showground.
- Body protectors meeting the BETA 2018 Level 3 standard/EN 13158:2018 and up to standard skull caps, as above, must be worn for all arena eventing classes.

Horse Welfare

- No person who has a conviction or pending conviction for animal cruelty will be permitted to compete or attend.
- The show will be strictly upholding that all elements of horse welfare are maintained and upheld across the showground. Organisers, stewards and appointed officials have the authority to intervene in any situation where horse welfare is compromised which may lead to elimination of competitors.

Showing Standards

- No exhibitor may enter or show a horse/pony under a judge who is known to have bred, sold, produced or received financial gain for that horse/pony. (Stud fees are exempt from financial gain).
- People leading ponies in Leading Rein classes must be sixteen years old or over.
- Handlers 14 years & under competing the in-hand classes are required to wear a up to standard hard hat.
- Stallions – Appropriate stallion bridle discs must be worn.
- Stallions - Riders of small breeds must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders of large breeds must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
- Riders, handlers and their grooms must, at all times, present themselves in the show ring correctly, neatly and smartly dressed. All Grooms must wear a head covering/hat whilst in the show ring.
- Mountain and Moorland Classes are open to Mountain and Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure-Bred societies of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland, Welsh A, B, C and D. Stallion, mare, gelding, colt and filly. Rider any age unless stipulated as above.

### **Qualifications/Specific Rules – Sunshine Tours**

This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour Championships held at The All-England Showground, Hickstead from Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> – Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2026. The Championships are for unaffiliated and amateur competitors in Dressage from Intro to Elementary, Show Jumping from Lead Rein to 1.05m; Showing for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, Eventer's Challenge from 50cm through to 90cm.  
 Qualification: Dressage & Show Jumping 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> place; Showing & Eventers Challenge 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> place.

## **PERFORMANCE CLASSES**

### **Method of judging for Performance Classes (Class 16 to Class 19):**

Performance 70 Marks: Manners and Way of Going 10 Marks: Presentation, suitability and condition 10 Marks: Type and Freedom of Action 10 Marks: TOTAL 100 Marks

Exhibitors will go round the ring as whole group, (no pull in). They will then undertake an individual display (rather than a show) where they need to show certain movements which will include walk, trot, canter on both reins, a canter circle, canter transitions on the straight, extension in canter on one rein and free walk on a long rein and halt. Competitors in these classes will not be stripped.

**Rules:** Competitors may use any suitable bridle including Micklem bridles, flash or grackle nosebands and a correctly fitted running martingale. Coloured or plain browbands can be used depending on the type of pony/horse being shown. All Ponies or Horses in the Performance Classes must be plaited, except for Coloured Native/Cob/Traditional animals which may be shown unplaited or hogged. Mountain and Moorland Ponies will not be penalised in the Performance Classes for having non pulled tails and feathers but must be plaited. Running plaits are acceptable, but the forelock must be plaited.

#### **CLASS 24 – INTER TEAM RELAY**

Horses and ponies must be 5years and above.

Teams of four from each club to enter, every member must be competent jumping 70cm at speed and confident in a race environment. There will be a mirrored course set up (so two teams can compete at the same time) of mainly working hunter style jumps, of approximately 70cm and to include one or more non jumping tasks. There will be a ground start and finish pole to which each team member has to stay behind and cross before next member goes.

All members must be dressed correctly and smartly for showjumping or eventing, as they would represent their club.

This is a timed competition, and the starting order will be drawn.

The competition will be run as a knock-out relay and the time taken from the start of the first rider to the finish of the final competitor. 5 seconds will be added to the time for a knockdown.

If a competitor is eliminated for three or more refusals another competitor must complete their round for them.

In the event of a fall by rider, the time will keep ticking but penalties won't be added. At the discretion of the judge/medical team, the rider may continue once remounted. Another rider can continue the course in their place once the rider is up and on their feet, when it's deemed safe to do so by the judge. In the event of a horse fall, the team will be automatically eliminated.
